WRITERS ON THE MOON



In 2021, Tina was accepted into the Writers on the Moon project, led by Dr. Susan K. Quinn. Her books will join the Astrobotic's Peregrine Mission 1. the payload will be delivered to Lacus Mortis, on the Moon, for future anthropologists and generations. The digital payload will be uploaded onto a SanDisk Extreme microSD card and sent to the Moon for posterity.

Astrobotic, a space logistics company and an official partner of NASA, will deliver the Writers On The Moon payload.

This mission is the first commercial launch, which includes payloads from NASA, DLR —German Aerospace Center, Bosch, and even Dogecoin. The launch is slated for 2022.

Glasneck, an author of more than twenty titles, is sending her catalog of Norse mythology-inspired fantasy novels to the Moon as a beacon of hope. "Future space travelers will discover the lunar time capsule and learn about our culture and world through the items we've left behind," says Glasneck, "just like we've learned about the Norse, Egyptian and Greek cultures before us."

Glasneck, who also writes about Norse gods like Loki and Thor, is always looking for a chance to bring history and myth to life. She says that since she has so much joy in doing so, even more opportunities continually arise. "I like to think that the Norse gods are giving me a boon as I help to share their myths."

Her fantasy books, specifically the Hell Chronicles, follow the Norse gods after their arrival to Earth. "I like to call the series 'Buffy' meets 'American Gods'. It's what happens when the Earth needs a hero and the only one available is a feisty heroine willing to risk it all for humanity."

"The Norse myths continue to teach me something new every day," she continues. "My favorite deity is Loki, as he's an agent of change. I find that the myths show that we can continue to push forward."
